The project aims at bringing together children of Khmer and Vietnamese origin so that they learn to live together in harmony

- To expose the children from early childhood to the Khmer language through a basic pre-school education
- To train young people from the local community to become educators for pre-school kids
- To foster the conviction among parents that their children will have a better future and that the community can contribute to that future

Activities

- The 3 pre-schools offer daily education to children from 3 to 7 years old
- All teachers are well-trained, young, motivated members of the local community
- Children participate in multiple, diverse activities and also enjoy a daily rice meal
